

## 12+ WAYS TO STRENGTHEN RELATIONSHIPS, BUILD UNITY AND PREVENT CONFLICT IN A CARENET CENTER

**Synopsis**: This breakout session will cover 12 key principles and practices for improving emotional intelligence, empathy, peacemaking, and problem-solving skills of pregnancy center leaders and workers. ## A. MODEL RELATIONAL LEADERSHIP

- 1. Healthy CareNet Centers have relational leaders (Matt. 22:37-39; 1 Thess. 1:7-8).
- 2. Relational leaders <u>model humility</u>, teachability and <u>flexibility</u> (Phil. 2:3-4)
- 3. Relational leaders deliberately improve their relational wisdom (Matt. 22:37-39)
- 4. Relational leaders are <u>skilled peacemakers</u> who <u>model confession</u> and inspire the "<u>Golden Result</u>" (Matt. 5:9; James 3:18; Matt. 7:12).
- 5. Relational leaders understand the seductiveness of power and its potential for abuse; (see <a href="Power Causes Brain Damage">Power Causes Brain Damage</a> and <a href="Psychology of Power">Psychology of Power</a>; contrast with <a href="Reagan">Reagan</a>, Lincoln, RW and You and Lincoln's Relational Wisdom).
- 6. Relational leaders realize that sin can turn strengths into weaknesses (1 Cor. 8:1).
- 7. Relational leaders are <u>always bringing the gospel to their people</u> (Rom. 5:1-11).
- 8. Relational leaders develop and model empathy and compassion (Col. 3:12).
- 9. Relational leaders are both approachable and accountable (Luke 7:37-38; Matt. 8:9).
- 10. Relational leaders are always <u>building passport</u> (John 4:7-30).
- 11. Relational leaders provide the Three P's of Satisfaction (1 Cor. 14:40; Matt. 7:120.
- 12. Relational leaders practice clarity plus charity (Matt. 7:12)
- 13. Relational leaders know how to <u>defuse explosive meetings</u> (Matt. 7:3-5).
- 14. Relational leaders encourage and inspire others to be better (1 Thess. 5:11).
- 15. Relational leaders apply RW in every challenge of life, including <u>cancer</u>.

## **B.** A STRATEGY FOR GROWTH

- 1. Pray for guidance.
- 2. Develop a plan for personal and organizational growth (<u>Download template here</u>)
- 3. Start with yourself; practice these things, set an example (1 Tim. 4:15).
