FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT SKILLS CAN I LEARN THROUGH YOUR TRAINING?

RW360 training integrates the principles of relational wisdom (biblical emotional intelligence), relational peacemaking, coaching, Christian conciliation and shepherding.

WHERE SHOULD I START MY TRAINING?

All of RW360's training is based on two required foundational courses: **Discovering Relational Wisdom** and **Relational Peacemaking**. You may complete these two courses in either order and then proceed with higher levels of training.

HOW DO YOU DEFINE THESE SKILL SETS?

Relational Wisdom, in essence, is the desire and ability to obey Jesus' timeless command, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart ... and love your neighbor as yourself" (Matt. 22:37-39). To put it another way, relational wisdom (RW) is a theological paradigm that combines the <u>gospel</u>, the wisdom-principles of scripture and our God-given capacity for "<u>emotional intelligence</u>" into a discipleship paradigm for developing skills that strengthen relationships and prevent conflict (<u>dig deeper here</u>).

Relational Peacemaking is a systematic theology for resolving conflict and reconciling people. This training is based on Ken Sande's book, <u>The Peacemaker</u>, which has sold over 500,000 copies in 20 languages and is organized under four key principles (the "4 G's"): Glorify God, Get the Log Out of Your Own Eye, Gently Restore and Go and Be Reconciled (<u>dig deeper here</u>).



RW Shepherding involves the application of RW, peacemaking, coaching and conciliation skills by church or ministry leaders. This training is especially relevant to <u>pastors</u> but is also useful for elders, deacons and anyone else in ministry leadership.

Conflict Coaching assists others to resolve existing conflicts personally and privately by applying the principles of relational wisdom and peacemaking.

RW Life Coaching is a special form of "life coaching" that focuses on assisting other individuals to improve their relational skills in order to build stronger, deeper and more resilient relationships and to "get upstream of future conflict."

Christian Conciliation is a process for resolving disputes between Christians in a biblically faithful manner. This process may involve conflict coaching (advising individuals how to resolve a dispute personally and privately), mediation (meeting with both parties to improve understanding and facilitate a voluntary agreement) or arbitration (a trusted individual resolves a conflict by rendering a binding decision). These processes are described in detail in Guiding People Through Conflict.

WHERE CAN I APPLY THESE SKILLS?

You can apply these principles to strengthen relationships and resolve conflicts in all areas of life, including church leadership, the workplace, marriage and parenting, and legal disputes ... and then teach and assist others to do the same!

IS THIS TRAINING DESIGNED ONLY FOR PROFESSIONALS?

No. Although professionals can improve their skills and credentials through this training, all of our foundational and basic courses are designed to teach relational skills that can be applied by non-professionals in everyday life.

WHAT ARE THE FOUR LEVELS OF YOUR TRAINING?

<u>Foundational Personal Skills Training</u> is designed to equip individuals to **personally apply** the principles of relational wisdom and peacemaking in their own families, churches and workplaces.

Basic Assisting Training is designed to equip individuals to assist others to learn and practice relational wisdom and peacemaking in their families, churches and work lives. This training is specifically designed for people who wish to serve on a church-based Peace Sower Team.

Advanced Assisting Training is designed to equip pastors, church, ministry and nonprofit leaders and workplace managers with enhanced skills that improve their job performance and enable them to lead and serve others more effectively. This level of training also qualifies individuals to charge fees for some of these services.

<u>Certification Training</u> is designed to provide ongoing training and accountability for individuals who are serving as coaches or conciliators at a **professional level**.





WHAT IS A PEACE SOWER TEAM?

Peace Sower Teams are comprised of volunteer instructors, coaches and conciliators who serve their church or ministry by equipping and assisting others to practice relational wisdom and peacemaking in their daily lives, thereby addressing relational issues before they require pastoral counseling or intervention (dig deeper).

ARE THERE OTHER PREREQUISITES FOR RW360 TRAINING?

All assisting courses have prequisites, which are given at the top of each course page.

WHICH TYPE OF ASSISTING TRAINING IS BEST FOR ME?

As illustrated by the flow chart at the beginning of this section, our training program is designed to allow you to complete different types and levels of training one course at a time, which allows you learn a variety of interrelated concepts and decide whether it would be useful for you to move on to another type or higher level of training.

If you are involved in **church or ministry leadership**, we suggest that you follow the **RW Shepherd** track, which will introduce you to a variety of ways that you can apply relational wisdom, peacemaking and conciliation in your ministry. This track also allows you to simultaneously complete most of the requirements for an RW Instructor Certificate, which you can obtain with a little extra work and no additional fee.

If your primary interest is to **teach relational wisdom and peacemaking**, you should follow the **RW Instructor track**.

If you desire to serve others as a **coach or conciliator**, you should pursue the **RW Coach** track, which includes prerequiste courses for the **RW Conciliator** track.

CAN I COMPLETE COURSES SIMULTANEOUSLY?

Yes. Some of the requirements for different courses are the same, so as you complete one course, you are often satisfying the requirements for other courses, which will allow you to obtain additional training certificates more quickly.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE RW360 COURSES?

As indicated in the chart at the end of this section, some courses can be completed in as little as 6 hours, while others can take up to 46 hours. All courses are self-paced, so you can move through them at your own pace.

CAN YOUR TRAINING RESOURCES BE USED IN SECULAR SETTINGS?

Yes. All of our resources are grounded on biblical principles and are most commonly used in church and ministry settings. Even so, we have developed a "<u>values-based</u>" version of our relational wisdom course (<u>Exploring Relational Wisdom</u>) so that it can be studied and taught in businesses, schools, hospitals, military bases, police departments and other seculur settings, which can open the way for non-Christians to encounter the gospel (see <u>RW and Evangelism</u>).



ARE THERE STUDIES THAT SHOW HOW THIS TRAINING CAN BENEFIT BOTH EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES?

Yes. Studies have shown that this type of training produces more creative, loyal, fulfilled and productive employees who experience better career advancement. Employers can also see major benefits. As one study concluded, "When companies invest in the physical and relational wellness of their workers, returns on investment can range between \$1.50 and \$6.85 for every dollar spent on these types of programs." (dig deeper)

HAS YOUR TRAINING BEEN APPROVED FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT?

Yes. Some of our training has been approved for continuing education for teachers, nurses, lawyers, counselors and social workers (see details here).

IS YOUR TRAINING AVAILABLE BOTH ONLINE AND LIVE?

All of our core training courses are available online at the <u>RW Academy</u>. Much of our training is also available through <u>live seminars and webinars</u>. Our foundational courses in relational wisdom and relational peacemaking are also available in video-based <u>group study sets</u> that can be used for Sunday school classes or live small group studies.

Our annual <u>Sowing Peace Conference</u> is a live gathering that provides opportunities to be inspired by nationally recognized speakers, to develop friendships with like-minded people and to form mentoring relationships with experienced individuals who can accelerate your growth as a shepherd, instructor, coach or conciliator.

IS ALL OF YOUR TRAINING CURRENTLY AVAILABLE?

No. Some of our Advanced courses are still under development and will be completed during 2023 and the first part of 2024. Course requirements and costs are subject to change as RW360 integrates new content.

HOW CAN I BRING THIS TRAINING INTO MY CHURCH OR ORGANIZATION?

It is usually wise to personally test drive our training before you try to promote it more widely. Therefore, we suggest that you complete one of our foundational courses on your own to make sure it is compatible with your organization's values and goals. Better yet, invite a small group of others to join you in a study so that several people can testify to your organization's leadeship about the benefits of this training.

- 1. Several courses have some of the same study requirements, so the time and cost to complete additional higher level courses is often less than indicated in this chart.
- 2. Cost covers registration fees and does not include cost of books.
- 3. Study hours are approximate and will vary from person to person. For example, although most people take about 10 hours to complete the Discovering Relational Wisdom course, others have invested 30 or more hours in the course as they read all of the additional optional articles and write longer answers to application questions.
- 4. Since higher level courses require the completion of lower level prerequisites, the total investment for higher level courses is the sum of all the related costs and time requirements. For example:
 - The total cost for **Basic RW Instructor** training is **\$193** (\$49+\$49 \$95) and takes approximately **55 hours** to complete (10+14+31)
 - The total cost for **Basic RW Coach** training is **\$440** (\$49+\$49+\$95+\$95+\$145+\$145) and takes approximately **92 hours** to complete (10+14+6+9.5+25+28).

Note, however, that 24 hours of the time invested in an Instructor Certificate automatically applies to the time required for a Coach Certificate. Many of these hours would also apply to RW Shepherd and RW Conciliator training as well.

DISCOVERING RELATIONAL WISDOMTM CERTIFICATE

Cost: \$49 | Study Time: 10 hours

Relational wisdom (RW), in essence, is your ability to love God with all your heart and to love your neighbor as yourself ... in other words, RW is simply your ability to live out the two Great Commandments as summarized by Jesus in Mattew 22:37-39.

In modern terms, relational wisdom may be defined as a biblically-grounded, gospel-driven form of emotional intelligence that enables you to discern emotions, interests and abilities in yourself and others, to interpret this information in the light of God's Word, and to use these insights to manage your responses and relationships constructively.

One of the easiest ways to begin improving your relational wisdom is to go through RW360's **online course**, *Discovering Relational Wisdom*, which is available for \$49 through the RW Academy. You can complete the course on your own, but studying with a spouse, friend or co-worker makes the training more enjoyable and life-changing.

Another way you could study these concepts is to lead an eight-week *Discovering Relational Wisdom* **group study**. Group study sets are available in both a <u>faith-based (Christian)</u> <u>version</u>, which is designed for Sunday school or a home study group, and a <u>values-based</u> (<u>secular</u>) <u>version</u>, which is designed for use in the workplace and other secular settings for <u>professional development</u>.

No special training is required to lead a group study since all of the actual teaching is provided by video (DVD or flash drive). As a moderator, your role is simply to host meetings (in person or by phone or video conferencing), play the videos and lead discussions using the application questions in the course materials.

You can use these resources to teach relational wisdom to **every person in your church, ministry or business** as a way to strengthen relationships, improve unity and teamwork and equip people with skills that enable them to "get upstream of conflict."

RELATIONAL PEACEMAKINGTM CERTIFICATE

Cost: \$49 | Study Time: 12-14 hours

RW360's Relational Peacemaking course integrates relational wisdom with the peacemaking principles set forth in *The Peacemaker: A Biblical Guide to Resolving Personal Conflict.*

This training will strengthen your ability to live out the peacemaking concepts of confession, repentance, correction, forgiveness, negotiation, mediation and arbitration to resolve conflicts in a way that honors God, promotes justice, restores relationships and, most importantly, demonstrates the reconciling power of the gospel.

One of the easiest ways to begin improving your peacemaking skills is to go through RW360's **online course**, *Relational Peacemaking*. You can complete the course on your own, but studying with a spouse, friend or co-worker makes the training more enjoyable and life-changing.

Another way you could study these concepts is to lead a twelve-week <u>Relational</u> <u>Peacemaking group study</u>. This study is currently available in a faith-based (Christian) version, which is designed for Sunday school or a home study group, and will eventually be available in a values-based (secular) version, which is designed for use in the workplace and other secular settings for <u>professional development</u>.

No special training is required to lead a group study since all of the actual teaching is provided by video (DVD or flash drive). As a moderator, your role is simply to host meetings (in person or by phone or video conferencing), play the videos and lead discussions using the application questions in the course materials.

You can use these resources to teach biblical conflict resolution to **every person in your church, ministry or business** to strengthen relationships, improve unity and teamwork and equip people with skills that enable them to "get upstream of conflict."

ADVANCED RW SHEPHERDTM CERTIFICATE¹

Purpose: Individuals who demonstrate substantial skill and experience as an RW Shepherd may apply for advanced training that will enhance their ability to build a relational culture in their church by modeling, teaching and assisting others in practicing RW and peacemaking in challenging life situations (1 Tim. 4:15).

Advanced RW Shepherds are trained to implement RW360's legal risk management resources to reduce exposure to legal liability while carrying our pastoral ministry. They are also equipped to use RW360's <u>values-based</u> resources for community outreach, evangelism and church growth (see <u>Using RW for Witnessing and Evangelism</u>).

PEACE SOWER TEAMSTM

Peace Sower Teams are comprised of volunteer instructors, coaches and conciliators who serve your church or ministry by equipping and assisting others to practice relational wisdom and peacemaking in their daily lives, thereby addressing relational issues before they require pastoral counseling or other intervention.

When your church or ministry enrolls in the Peace Sower Team program, you will receive a detailed manual to guide you through key aspects of establishing a Peace Sower Team, including recruiting, training and managing team members; accountability to church or ministry leadership; church-wide promotion and training; and community outreach.

RW InstructorTM Certificate

Purpose: RW Instructors are trained to facilitate **video-based group studies** on relational wisdom and peacemaking through Sunday school classes and small group studies. Instructor training is designed to improve your ability to facilitate both <u>faith-based</u> and <u>values-based</u> study groups by leading interactive discussions, asking insightful questions and assisting people in learning how to apply these concepts in their daily lives. You will also learn how to use the RW360 smartphone app and other RW resources as witnessing tools to share your faith with others.

ADVANCED RW INSTRUCTORTM CERTIFICATE²

Purpose: Individuals who demonstrate substantial skill and experience as an RW Instructor may apply for advanced training that prepares them for an expanded teaching ministry that includes:

- Teaching of the relational wisdom and peacemaking courses through live webinars and seminars (rather than using teaching videos);
- Customizing the courses for particular venues, such as the workplace, law enforcement, prisons, military, missions, retreats, etc.);
- Being included on RW360's online <u>Directory</u>;
- Teaching on a professional (fee based) basis (see e.g., <u>Anchor Point with Patti Damiani</u> and <u>Lessons for Life with James Long, Jr.</u>);
- Using RW360's <u>values-based</u> resources to serve their communities by making introductory presentations to businesses, schools, police departments, military bases and other secular venues (see <u>Using RW for Witnessing and Evangelism</u> and RW Training Strengthens Both Businesses and Families).

INTRODUCTION TO RW COACHINGTM CERTIFICATE COACHING FRIENDS IN EVERYDAY CONVERSATIONS

Purpose: Introduction to Coaching training will equip you to have an informal personal conversation with friends, coworkers or family members, perhaps over coffee or a meal, in which you assist them in discerning and planning ways that they can make wise life choices, strengthen specific relational skills or restore strained relationships by applying relevant principles of relational wisdom or biblical peacemaking.

These coaching skills can be used informally with friends, family and coworkers, and are especially helpful to pastors, church leaders and business managers who want to help others improve their relational skills and learn how to make wise choices on their own.

This training provides a brief introduction to the four-step *RW Coaching Paradigm* and shows how it can be applied in a variety of life situations. It will also help you to evaluate how relevant these skills are to your life and to decide whether to continue with further coaching training.

RW COACHING SKILLSTM CERTIFICATE

Purpose: Coaching Skills training is designed to complement and enhance the Introduction to RW Coaching course. It focuses on three crucial coaching skills: active listening; asking powerful questions; and creating effective action steps. This course will provide opportunities to both learn and practice these enhanced skills.



This training provides practice in applying the four-step *RW Coaching Paradigm*, but these skills apply equally well to RW360's other academic offerings (shepherding, instructing and conciliation).

Students may take this course before they pursue the *Introduction to Coaching Certificate*, but this training is usually more helpful if it follows the *Introduction to Coaching* course. Both courses are prerequisites for the RW Life Coaching Certificate and the RW Conflict Coaching Certificate.

Purpose: RW Life Coaching training is a relationally focused form of life coaching that will equip you to assist others in accelerating their practice of relational wisdom, enabling them to build stronger relationships and "get upstream of conflict."

A key goal of this type of coaching is to help others strengthen and apply relational wisdom so they are less likely to experience serious relational problems that would eventually require pastoral intervention or prolonged counseling.

CERTIFIED RW COACHTM CERTIFICATE

RW360's **Certification Program** is designed to provide ongoing training and accountability to individuals who have completed our Advanced Training and are frequently serving as coaches at a **professional level**. We are still developing the requirements and terminology for this level of professional training and certification. In general, however, in order to be certified as an RW Coach, individuals will be required to:

- 1. Demonstrate a high level of experience and competence as an Advanced RW Coach, either by working closely with another Certified RW Coach for several hours in actual coaching cases or by passing a detailed interview process led by a panel of Certified RW Coaches.
- 2. Serve as a coach for specified number of hours per year (e.g., 12 hours per month).
- 3. Participate regularly in online Iron Sharpening Iron Webinars that foster continued skill development and interaction with like-minded coaches.
- 4. Complete approved continuing education training and a specified number of hours of mentor coaching every three years.
- **5.** Conduct their practice consistent with RW360's <u>Standard of Conduct for Christian Conciliation</u> and accountability policies (see, e.g., <u>Conciliator Grievance Policy</u>).

CERTIFIED RW CONCILIATORTM CERTIFICATE

RW360's **Certification Program** is designed to provide ongoing training and accountability to individuals who have completed our Advanced Training and are frequently serving as conciliators at a **professional level**.

In order to qualify for the designation as a Certified RW Conciliator, individuals will be required to:

- 1. Submit an Application for Certified RW Conciliator Training;
- 2. Demonstrate a high level of experience and competence as an Advanced RW Conciliator, either by working closely with another Certified RW Conciliator for several hours in actual conciliation cases or by passing a detailed interview process led by a panel of Certified RW Conciliators.
- 3. Pay annual \$95.
- 4. Serve as a conciliator for at least 150 hours per year (~12 hours per month);
- 5. Participate regularly in Iron Sharpening Iron Webinars that foster continued skill development and interaction with like-minded conciliators;
- 6. Acquire at least ten hours of approved continuing education per year; and
- 7. Conduct their practice consistent with RW360's <u>Standard of Conduct for Christian Conciliation</u> and accountability policies (see, e.g., <u>Conciliator Grievance Policy</u>).

CERTIFICATE IN APPLIED RELATIONAL WISDOMTM

Purpose: This program is designed to strengthen individuals' emotional intelligence, relational and conflict resolution skills by providing students opportunities to learn and apply these principles in specific life venues, such as schools, workplace management, healthcare, law enforcement and the military. For example:

- Enhancing Relational Skills and Reducing Conflict in a Christian School
- Enhancing Relational Skills and Reducing Conflict in a Public School
- Relational Wisdom for Military Chaplains

Key principles are initially applied through hypothetical case studies in specialty areas. Students then apply the principles to actual relational challenges in their own lives, both personally and vocationally. Finally, they learn how to share these concepts and the gospel itself with their friends and coworkers.

Prerequisites: Complete *Discovering Relational Wisdom* and *Relational Peacemaking*, either online through the <u>RW Academy</u> or by leading group studies, which are available through the <u>RW360 Bookstore</u>.

Training requirements:
