## About Kevin Thornsberry

Kevin timidly offered to assist in his first church conflict in 2002, when he helped two church members reconcile over limited ministry resources. Over the years since then, he has marveled at watching the Holy Spirit bring healing in increasingly complex disputes. Kevin's experience has been focused primarily on marriage and family conciliation and helping church staff and leadership learn to serve together again when trust has been damaged.

Kevin became a Certified Christian Conciliator™ in 2012, and in addition to helping believers reconcile conflicted relationships, he has trained pastors, church leaders, and conciliators domestically and abroad. In October 2020, Kevin retired from a career as a reservoir engineer in the oil and gas industry. That career also served as a vehicle to conciliate cases and train pastors on the African continent. Since then, Kevin has been able to devote more time to assisting people in conflict and to teaching. He received a certificate in Biblical Counseling in 2009 from the Riley Center of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, TX.

Kevin's conciliation work increasingly occurs through video conference as he serves out-of-state clients. He and his wife, Pam, also offer onsite intensive mediation services to restore broken marriages. Kevin and Pam have two daughters who are also devoted followers of Christ, women of character who serve with gladness in their churches.

Kevin's heart is to support the church in its call to function in unity as one body with one spirit and with one hope and one Lord, one faith and one baptism (Eph 4:4-6). In his own church, Kevin has served in many capacities, including as a teacher, ministry leader, deacon, and staff advisor.
